

2013 Year-End Update

In 2013, Canadian Nuclear Partners (CNP) transformed from a business concept into an active entity with a clear mission: *to work with nuclear and power sector industries, in Canada and around the world, to deliver sustainable safety, value for money, operational and human performance excellence.*

CNP's first project was to provide technical support and oversight spanning the return to service of New Brunswick Power's Point Lepreau Generating Station (PLGS). Our involvement was a success. As a result, on March 1, 2013 OPG began a multi-year partnership with PLGS to continue providing support and advisory services in areas such as engineering, training, and operations and maintenance.

In 2013, CNP also safely provided services to companies such as Nova Scotia Power, TransAlta and Bruce Power. CNP provided technical advisory services for dam safety, hydroelectric turbine-generator repairs and fuel switching. CNP also provided advanced simulator-based training in CANDU inspection and maintenance techniques. Through partnerships with other service providers, CNP is building a reputation as a global leader in servicing and strengthening the electricity generation sector.

In 2014, CNP looks forward to building new partnerships and providing services to power companies in Canada and abroad.
